INFORMATION

Camp is above Irvine Regional Park. Enter through the Park Main gate.

When arriving there is a key pad past the ranger booth. The Gate code is: #0808

Please follow the signs to the camping area. Parking is near the camping area.

Arrive between: 4:00 pm and 7:00 pm Gate closes at 9:00 pm (No entry after this time)

Camping area

Please set up your tent on the decomposed granite. Please do not leave a lot of space between tents. We have a lot of tents to set up.

Things to bring and not bring

Tent, sleeping bag...ect. See the list of items for camp on the pack web site.

Pool: Bring your suit, sun screen, a chair for the deck, any pool toys. The camp will provide some pool noodles, kick boards and a few pool toys.

Do not bring a bb-gun or archery equipment.

Schedule:

Friday: arrive and eat dinner and set up camp. Camp orientation and cracker barrel

Lights out and quiet time after 10:00 pm

Saturday: quiet time until 6:00 am

Morning: get out of your tent, breakfast, archery and bb-gun and activities in camp

Afternoon: lunch, pool

Evening: dinner, campfire and cracker barrel

Lights out and quiet time after 10:00 pm

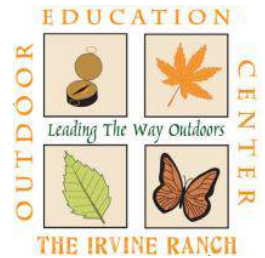
Sunday: quiet time until 6:00 am

Break camp and leave camp. Depart by 12:00 PM



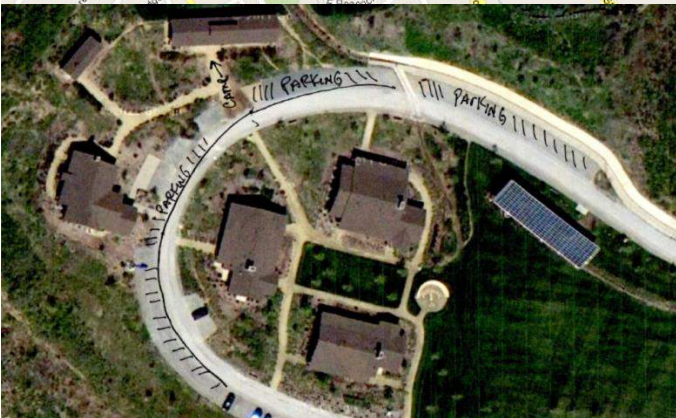
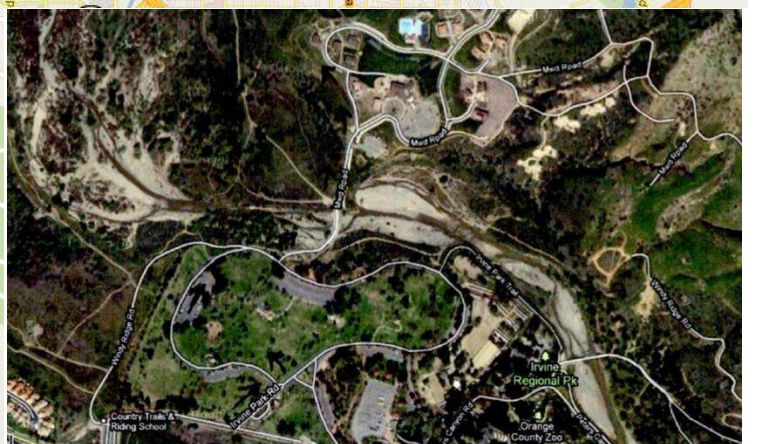
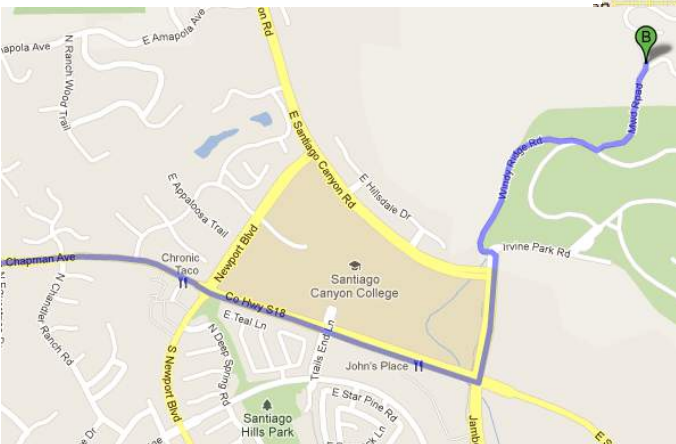
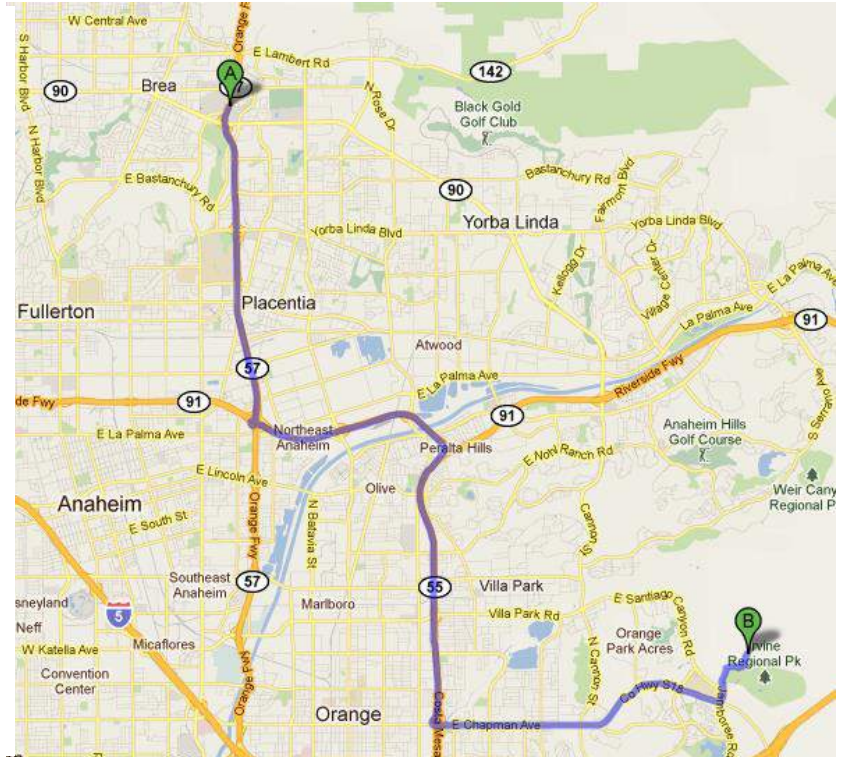

MAPS AND DIRECTIONS

1. Head **south** on **CA-57 S** 4.3 mi
2. Take exit **5A** to merge onto **CA-91 E/ Riverside Fwy** toward **Riverside** 3.2 mi
3. Take exit **34** to merge onto **CA-55 S** toward **Newport Beach** 3.9 mi
4. Take exit **14** for **Chapman Ave** 0.4 mi
5. Turn left onto **E Chapman Ave** 4.4 mi
6. Turn left onto **Jamboree Rd** 0.3 mi
7. Turn left onto **S Weir Canyon Rd** 387 ft
8. Continue onto **Windy Ridge Rd** 0.4 mi
9. Turn left onto **Mwd Rpad** 0.2 mi
10. Slight left 52 ft

WHAT TO BRING

Food & Drink

- All meals on Saturday & Sunday morning are provided by the camp.
- Bring along your own meal for Friday evening. You may want to bring your favorite snacks and bottled water for between meals. You may also want to bring your own coffee/hot chocolate mugs!
- If you bring food, bring animal-proof containers!

Shelter

- Tent
- Ground cover (moisture barrier under tent) - plastic tarp works fine
- Air mattress or camp mat (optional) - campsite is pretty flat
- Sleeping Bags
- Pillows (optional)
- Blankets (optional - used for top of sleeping bag and around campfire)
- Easy-Up for extra shade (optional)

Clothing (be prepared for all weather)

- Class A scout uniform shirt for Saturday evening campfire activities (**Remove ribbons, beads, and other "hanging" awards. Belt loops and neckerchiefs can stay at home.**)
- Class B scout uniform (pack T-shirt and den hat.)
- Comfortable clothes (jeans, sweats, shorts, etc.)
- Light and heavy jacket/hooded sweatshirt
- Gloves/beanies for extra warmth at night
- Comfortable, durable shoes – tennis/hiking boots
- Flip-flops or water sandals for showers & pool (foot covering required at all times)
- Extra socks!
- Rain slick/poncho (probably won't need it...but be prepared!)
- Thermal underwear/warm pajamas
- Swimsuits
- Towels (recommend two – for shower & for pool)
- Costumes for skits – for those of you who are creative

Additional Gear

- Pool / campfire chairs
- Water Bottle (filled)
- Bug repellent
- Sunscreen! – don't forget the sunscreen!
- Sunglasses
- Flashlights (better have one for each kid – or else) or Lanterns
- Spare batteries
- Toiletries, including but not limited to: toothbrush & toothpaste, shampoo, soap, lotion, wash cloth, Chap Stick, Kleenex, toilet paper, etc.
- Handi wipes, baby wipes, or other hand cleaner/sanitizer
- Sun hat or cap
- Hammer for tent stakes
- Camera

Optional Items:

- Sport toys (Frisbee, football, volleyball, , etc.)
- Pool Toys
- Kites

First Aid

- Basic first aid will be provided, but Band-Aids and Neosporin are good to have on hand
- Personal medicines/ointments
- Prescriptions

Prohibited Items

- Bikes
- Electronic toys
- Pocket knives
- Radios, boom boxes
- BB Guns, archery equipment.
- Alcohol
